Star skater of the month

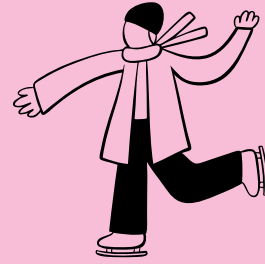

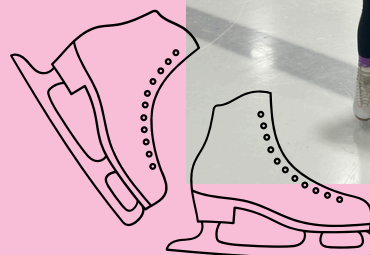
PreStar Skater of the Month
